<b>PS2</b>		Throughout their time in our 2 year old provision, our children are constantly given the opportunity to share and take turns with others and select and use activities with increasing independence. This supports them in developing their sense of responsibility and belonging to a community by becoming more familiar with adults in their setting, playing alongside other children and begin to follow rules. They are given opportunities to develop appropriate ways to talk with others to solve conflicts, talk about their feelings and gradually understand how others might be feeling.				
<b>EYFS</b>		Throughout their time in Foundation 1 & 2, our children are given the opportunity to share and take turns with others, and select and use activities and resources independently. This supports them in developing their sense of responsibility and membership of a community. They become more outgoing and become able to develop friendships with a wider group of children. They work together extending and elaborating play ideas, find solutions to conflicts and rivalries and follow rules. They are given opportunities to develop appropriate ways of being assertive, to develop their ability to talk with others to solve conflicts, to talk about their feelings and understand how others might be feeling. At St Paul's all children are supported to manage their emotions, develop a positive sense of self, set themselves simple goals, have confidence in their own abilities, to persist and wait for what they want and direct attention as necessary. Through adult modelling and guidance, they learn how to look after their bodies, including eating healthily, and manage their personal needs independently. Through supported interaction with other children they learn how to make good friendships, cooperate and resolve conflicts peacefully. British Values are introduced to children through the use of the Picture News resources. RSE is taught using the Journey in Love programme and the theme for EYFS is 'The wonder of being special and unique'
