Dear Parents,

A belated welcome back after half term. We hope you had an enjoyable break with the children.

Thursday 6th March World Book Day

The theme is "Read Your Way". The children will be taking part in lots of different activities throughout the day to engage them in 'Reading for Pleasure'. Class teachers will explain to the children what activities will be happening during the day, some of which are:

- World Book Day assembly
- The masked reader
- Used book sale 50p per book
- Reading to different year groups
- Guess the teacher from their favourite children's books
- Other book/reading themed activities

Children can dress up as a book character on Thursday to celebrate. If they do not want to dress up, then they **must** come into school in their school uniform. Please note children cannot dress in football kits, belly tops, ripped jeans, slippers or crocs.

Uniform and PE kits

The full uniform policy is available on the school website. In summary St Paul's school uniform is as follows:

- Blue sweatshirt or cardigan (with or without the school logo) not grey
- White or blue polo shirt not grey
- Grey or black trousers (joggers can be worn in Early Years)
- Grey or black skirt (in summer, a blue and white summer dress may be worn) not yellow, purple or any other colour
- **Black**, sensible shoes (Open-toed sandals, jelly shoes and crocs are not suitable footwear for school)

These items can be purchased from local supermarkets or from local online suppliers if parents want to add the logo to their child's clothing.

All items of clothing and footwear must be labelled with the pupil's name.



Our PE Kit is as follows:

- Plain white T-shirt
- Plain black shorts or plain black joggers in winter
- Plain, black, suitable trainers or black pumps

Jewellery should not be worn at school for health and safety reasons. One pair of small gold/silver studs may be worn but not sparkly or dangly earrings please. All earrings must be removed on PE days. No other jewellery should be worn in school. Thank you for your co-operation in this.
