Children's Bingo

On the afternoon of Thursday 30th November the children will be invited to take part in a Christmas Bingo. There is no charge for this but we ask that children bring a bottle for our bottle stall at the Christmas Fair. This can be a bottle of pop, shampoo, ketchup, juice, bubble bath etc. Thanks for your support in this.

Adult's Bingo

Our popular Over 18s Christmas Bingo is back by popular demand and is also on 30th November from 7 pm. Tickets are priced at £5 and are available from the school office. Tea, coffee, soft drinks and snacks will be on sale on the night. There will also be a raffle. Thank you to some of our parishioners/nans who have done so much to support this event already.

Enrolment Mass

The enrolment Mass for children making their First Holy Communion this year will be on Sunday 3rd December at the 9.30 Mass.

Carol Singing

We have been asked to provide a choir for the WIRED Christmas lunch at the Community Centre on Wednesday 6th December. Also on that day a choir of children from KS2 will attend the Advent Service with other local Catholic schools at St Michael's in Woodchurch. Then on Thursday 7th December we have been asked to sing at Morrison's in New Brighton.

Christmas Dinner

This will take place on Thursday 7th December at lunchtime. If your child normally brings a packed lunch but you would like them to have a Christmas Dinner please contact the office by Wednesday 29th November to place an order. On this day children should be in school uniform but can wear their Christmas jumpers instead of their St Paul's jumpers in exchange of a pack of cakes for our Christmas Fair.

The children making their First Holy Communion this year will receive First Forgiveness after the morning Mass on Friday 8th December.

Late Night Movie

KS2 are invited to return to school at 4.45pm on Friday 8th December for our very popular Late Night Movie. The cost is £5 per child and includes all refreshments. Payment must be made through Parent Pay. Children can return to school in their pyjamas and bring a sleeping bag or blanket. They should not bring any food, drink, mobile phones or hand held devices. All children must be collected from school at 7.15 by a responsible adult over the age of 18 from their contact list. NB. Children who have not been following our school rules will not be allowed to purchase a ticket for this event.

Nativity Play – Foundation and KS1

The Nativity Play takes place in the church on Wednesday 13th December at 2.15pm. There is no charge for tickets but there will be a Christmas raffle on the day. Two tickets will be sent home to each Foundation and KS1 family – you must have your ticket with you to gain entrance. Please note secondary school children will not be admitted to this event.

We will be running our fundraising Christmas Fair on Friday 15th December from 2pm. Parents are welcome to attend. There will be stalls, games, craft stalls and refreshments. There may even be an appearance from a very special visitor! Tickets for the prize raffle will be sent out soon and payment should be made through Parent Pay.

KS2 Carols by candlelight


