## Dear Parents,

Your child has a place on the residential trip to Tattenhall on 26<sup>th</sup> and 27<sup>th</sup> March. Attached to this letter is a medical form which must be completed and returned to school as soon as possible. It is important that we know of any medical conditions/allergies your child has. All medications, including inhalers, should be clearly marked with your child's name and must be handed to Mrs Fenna on the day of travel.

Below is a list of things the children will need to bring with them along with a few non-essential but useful items. There is no need to supply a sleeping bag as duvets are provided. Please note - the children will take part in three activities all of which are outdoors and may result in clothing being damaged. Therefore, we would recommend you send old clothes for activity sessions.

## **Packing List**

- Toiletries soap, toothpaste and toothbrush etc. (please note deodorants must be roll on, no aerosols)
- Clothes three pairs of trousers, three t shirts, a hoodie or similar, two pairs of trainers (one of which is old and you don't mind it being damaged. Enough underwear and socks for two days plus an extra pair of each
- Waterproof jacket
- Large plastic bag for dirty clothes
- A bath towel
- Nightclothes and slippers
- A named water bottle
- A packed lunch is required for Wednesday and MUST be in a plastic carrier bag. <u>If you</u> require a school packed lunch, please inform staff by Monday 17<sup>th</sup> March

• Books, paper and pencil or other quiet activities (no electronic games or mobile phones allowed)
