#### Dear Parents.

Welcome to the new school year everyone. I hope you had a wonderful holiday with your children. It was great to see them all back today looking very smart in their school uniforms. As they may have told you we are having the heating system overhauled with new boilers installed and although the contractors worked very hard during the summer the work will not be completed for a couple of weeks yet. We have had to move out of some classrooms so a number of children are being taught in the hall. This means that we will not be able to run any after school clubs until the week beginning 18th September. We are sorry for the inconvenience this may cause but there is no alternative. Looking on the bright side, at least we will all be warm in the winter!

Just a reminder that in line with our uniform policy the only jewellery permitted in school is one pair of small stud earrings. A number of children had "dangly" earrings in today and this is a safety issue. Your co-operation in not allowing children to come to school with jewellery is very much appreciated.

Please ensure that your child has a PE kit in school – plain white t-shirt, plain black shorts and black pumps. Kits should be left in school in a clearly marked bag. If you could also add your child's name to each item of kit that would be very helpful. Names in school jumpers will also make life easier so thank you for that.

As mentioned in the letter sent out before the holidays, school now starts at 8.45 with the gate opening at 8.40. This means that the morning sessions for KS1 children will now run from 8.45 – 11.45. Please ensure your F1 child is collected at this time. The Twos morning sessions remain unchanged and run from 9.00 – 12.00 meaning that parents who have a child in each of the settings will have time to get to both children and will not be late at either gate.

We have always run top up sessions for F1 and Pre School Twos children if we have space and staffing in place. Charges for these sessions are paid through Parent Pay. This year the Governors have decided that the charge for top up sessions will have to be increased so from the week beginning 30<sup>th</sup> September the cost of a top up session will be £20.

Times for children in F1 accessing 30 hours are also set to change. From the week beginning 16<sup>th</sup> September sessions will be Monday – Thursday from 8.45 – 3.15 and Friday from 8.45 – 1pm. There will also be an option to top up for Friday afternoon. Please contact the office for details.

We do not have any part to play in the programme other than giving out the letters and providing a space for the nurses to complete the immunisations.
