<p>A sketch is a rapidly executed freehand drawing that is not intended to be a finished piece of work. Drawing is a form of visual art in which a person uses various drawing instruments to mark paper or another two-dimensional medium. Painting is the practice of applying paint, pigment, colour or other medium to a solid surface.</p>	<p>In visual art, mixed media is an artwork in which more than one medium or material is used. Assemblages and collages are two common examples of art using different media that will make use of different materials including cloth, paper, wood and found objects.</p>	<p>Sculpture is the branch of the visual arts that operates in three dimensions. Durable sculptural processes originally used carving and modelling, in stone, metal, ceramics, wood and other materials but since Modernism, there has been an almost complete freedom of materials and process.</p>
