

Half Term Class Information

Personal, Social, and Emotional Development

We will be welcoming new children into our class this term. The new children will be encouraged to teach the new children our routines and expectations. We will take the lead from the children and explore emotions and what a good friend looks like.

Communication and Language

We have daily stories and rhyme time which all the children participate in. The younger children will be expected to follow more complex instructions involving more than two steps. Our children are exposed to a rich vocabulary and are encouraged to say when they haven't understood something.

Physical Development

We spend time using the trim trail to build gross motor strength and indoors the children have yoga sessions, dough disco and practise with scissors to develop their fine motor skills. Our weekly PE sessions will have a dance focus and the children will learn to control small movements, keeping in time to the music.

Understanding the World

As part of our superhero theme the children will learn about superhero clothing and how our senses could be enhanced with super powers.

Expressive Arts and Design

The children will make superhero artifacts, populate a city scape and recreate superhero stories that they are familiar with and have discovered in school.

Literacy

We will continue to share stories daily and all children will receive daily phonics teaching. F1 children are exploring sound discrimination our F2 children should complete Phase 3 of our phonics program, which will allow them to write almost anything phonetically. F2 will begin to write longer sentences and use punctuation.

Mathematics

F1 will continue to consolidate their number knowledge and manipulate numbers to 10, understanding one more and one less and that when we count, the last number we say is the total. F2 children will learn that 0 is one less than 1. They will be comparing quantities, capacity and mass.

The children will be introduced to non standard measurement and different ways to measure time.
